


What are our goals?

Accelerator
(3 to 4 months)

Launchpad method with mentor network, intensive, free but after screening

Early stage Incubator (6 to 12 months)

(from business plan to market launch, business start – the first steps)

Mentor network, intensive, fee for service



Scale up (when ready!)

(from early business to SME)

Growth plan & support, access to manufacturing, distribution networks

(in exchange for equity)





(not time bound, specialist licensed kitchen facilities to experiment & do initial productions



NEIS (National Employment Incentive Scheme)

(integrated certificate IV to prepare business plan then mentoring/coaching during business start and initial growth – up to 24 months support)







What does it mean to you? Entrepreneurs

Entrepreneurs

- If you want to go fast, full time and your idea & team are ready
 - Accelerate your business idea to a business plan with mentors through Rocket Seeder or the Generator
 - Then Incubate your business and start it from the licensed kitchen
- If you are not sure yet or need time incubate your idea with MOK
- If an accelerator is not for you or you have started but cannot go full time or need to build whilst earning a base wage - explore the NEIS program
- If you are an early stage business you can explore growth options with Badalaya
- If you are a small business you can also access the incubator for product development and our growth partner for access to co manufacturing options

Some Q&As

- The accelerator is free you just need to qualify (idea, team ready & commitment)
- There is no seed funding for now only through the Generator (open to Monash alumn and sector agnostic)
- The incubator is fee for service but low cost
- We have a plug and play kitchen for specific projects where equipment can be rented in
- The NEIS program is opened to all who are unemployed including students
- We do not have all the technical answers and skills but we'll endeavour to find them with our partners (but costs might be involved!)



What does it mean to you? Corporate / partners

Corporate / partners

- Our focus is in Food (broadly defined)
- Our set up is designed as an end to end support network it can be leveraged as an
 access for ideas or entrepreneurs at an adequate cost
- Our accelerator program can be organised around a particular challenge (including IP commercialisation) you may want to sponsor and access solutions (or support them)
- Our incubator program can be organised for your internal programs or events
- Our program can anchor a dedicated program that fits your needs
- Our complete system can be used to funnel start ups or entrepreneurs you are currently connected with
- Our program would welcome route to market partners who would offer access to market opportunities to the entrepreneurs coming through





Not one size fits all! There are many ways in and out and many needs...

- Our accelerator will run <u>2 cohorts</u> a year of entrepreneur through an intensive idea to start-up program in foods potential for a corporate cohort in addition. 24 36 start-ups per annum.
- Our incubator will offer facilities and coaching for entrepreneurs or small businesses whose timing or needs do not fit acceleration, or for their initial phase of development after the accelerator
- NEIS offers an alternative to all, if they fit the criteria of the program and its funding requirements. Estimates 20 businesses a year created.
- Our infrastructure is designed for multiple use and will also service a range of fee for service needs (events, kitchen hire, ...)
- Finally our scale up partners (Badalaya, SproutX) offer a way to cross the start up valley of death
